



WHAT IS ALL 4 YOUTH?

All 4 Youth is a program between the Fresno County Superintendent of Schools the Fresno County Department of Behavioral Health and managed care plans, serving children and youth ages 0–22 who are experiencing challenges that impact them at school or at home. Designed to reduce barriers to care, All 4 Youth connects youth and their families with behavioral health services that are available at school, in the community, or in the home. The program accepts Medi-Cal and dual coverage, helping ensure families have access to the support they need to build a positive, healthy environment for learning and growth.

SERVICES INCLUDE:

Tier 1 | Prevention/Wellness Universal Support

- Prevention, education, and outreach
- 12 Wellness Centers across Fresno County
- Mental health trainings for students, families, and staff
- Family Partner support and early intervention
- Ages served: All

Tier 2 | Mild Mental Health Services

- On-site screenings, therapy, and assessments
- Integrated mental health staff at schools
- Group support and progress monitoring
- Wellness Coaches on campus
- Ages served: 0-25

Tier 3 | Moderate to Severe Services

- Individual/group therapy, case management, tele-psychiatry
- Services at school, home, or in the community
- Referrals to higher levels of care
- Collaboration with schools and outside agencies
- Ages served: 0-22
